PO = window "Praat Objects"

PE = window "Praat Edit"

PP = window "Praat Picture"

1 – Record sound, and rename, save and re-open objects

1.1	PO	New
1.2	PO	Record mono Sound...
1.3	SoundRecorder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Channels: Mono - Choose: microphone (e.g., Focusrite Forte) - Sampling frequency: 44.1 kHz Record (to start recording) Stop (to end recording) Play (to listen to the recording) Save to list (to place the recording in the PO's list of objects) Save to list and close (to place the recording in the PO's list of objects and closing the SoundRecorder)
1.4	PO	There now is an object entitled "n. Sound name" in the objects list
1.5	PO	Rename...
1.6	Rename object	Type 'sv' in the text line OK (The name 'sv' is arbitrarily chosen to indicate a sustained vowel)
1.7	PO	Save
1.8	PO	Save as WAV file...
1.9	Windows or iOS procedure	Appoint the location of the sound file on the hard disk If desired, rename the file before saving OK
1.10	PO	Open
1.11	PO	Read from file...
1.12	Windows or iOS procedure	Select the sound file on the hard disk OK
1.13	PO	The selected sound file (i.e., another sound object) has been added to the objects list
